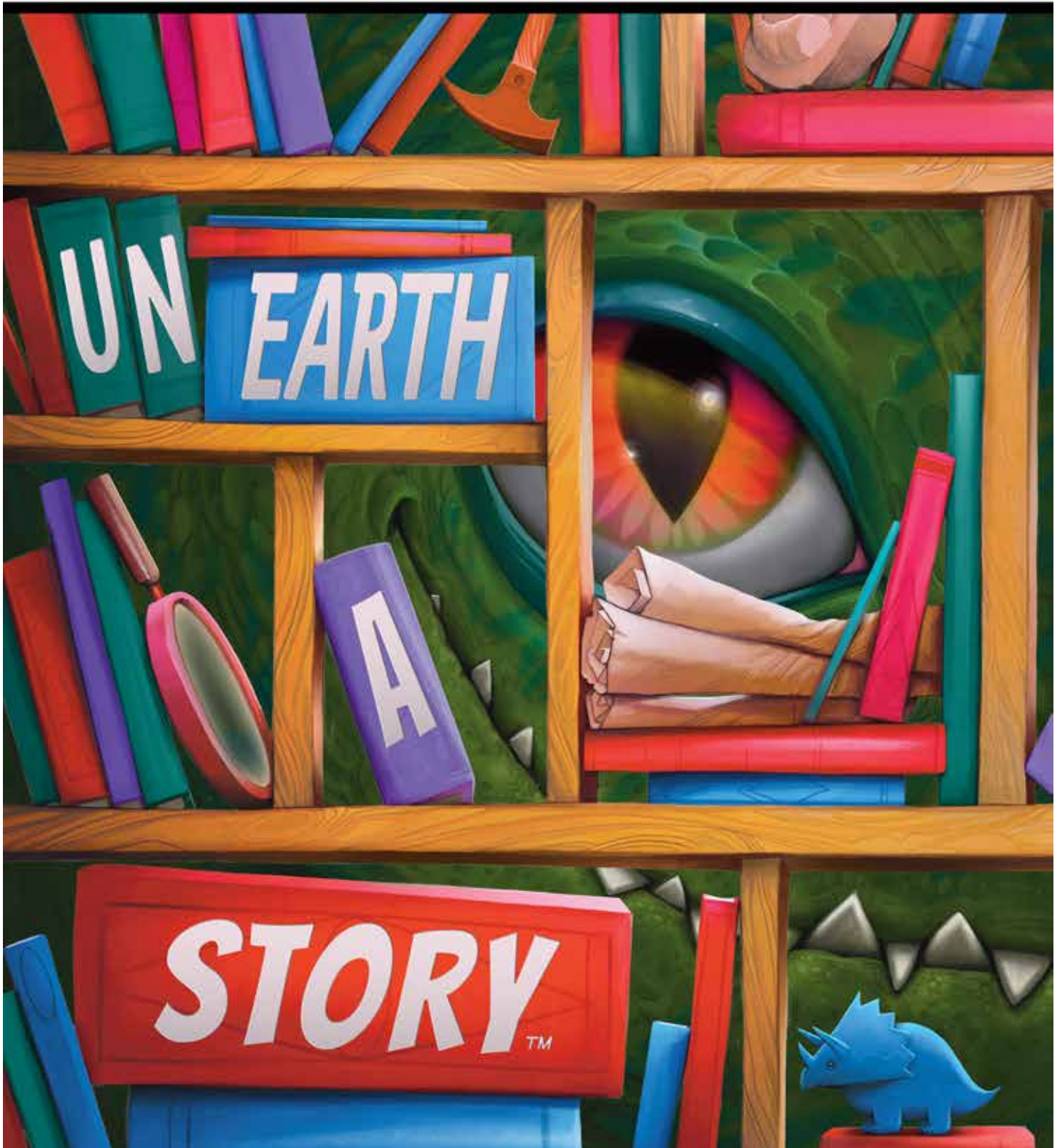

## 2026 Summer Reading Logs

*Begins Monday, June 1 for All Ages*

**Children** up to age 11 can pick up a Children's Reading Log Packet at the Children's Department desk. They'll track the titles they read, and younger children can join in with books read aloud to them. All formats count—picture books, chapter books, e-books, audiobooks, comics, graphic novels, nonfiction, and more. Children may track their reading on paper or through Reader Zone. From **Monday, July 20 to Monday, August 10**, completed logs can be turned in for a Reading Certificate, a book to keep, and a fun prize.

**Teens** can track their summer reading either on paper or through Reader Zone, earning points as they go. As they read, they'll unlock rewards like raffle entries, gift cards, and access to the prize cart. Every minute spent reading moves them closer to new milestones. All reading logs and entries must be turned in by **Tuesday, August 25**.

**Adults** can register to receive a reading packet and then track their reading minutes using either a paper log or Reader Zone. Everyone who completes and submits a full reading log will receive small prizes, and the top reader of the summer will earn a gift card of their choice. All completed logs must be submitted by **Saturday, August 29, at 5:00 pm**.

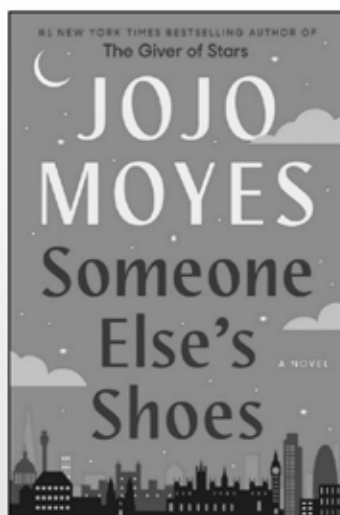
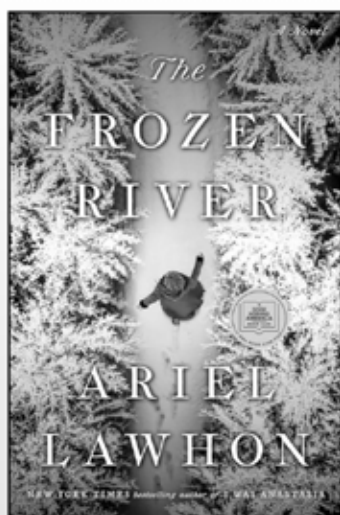

**To get onto Libby:**

1. Download the app or visit libbyapp.com.
2. Do you have a library card? Click **Yes**.
3. Use the **Search for a Library** function to search for your library, home collection, or zip code, and select the option most relevant (likely the first option).
4. Click **Sign In With My Card**, then click on the home collection or library name with the star.
5. Enter your library card number.
6. You are now signed in! Click next to browse and select materials.

**Libby now searches all of the library cards you have on your account.**

To add new cards available in the Northwest PA region:

1. Log in to your library's collection with your library card number.
2. Click on .
3. Click **Add Library**.
4. Search using the collection names on the reverse side.
5. Click **Sign in With My Card**.
6. Scroll to **Partner Libraries** and click on your home library.
7. Re-enter your card number.
8. Libby should now display as a new digital card in your account!
9. Repeat the process to access the other collections or for other library cards that provide you access to Libby.
