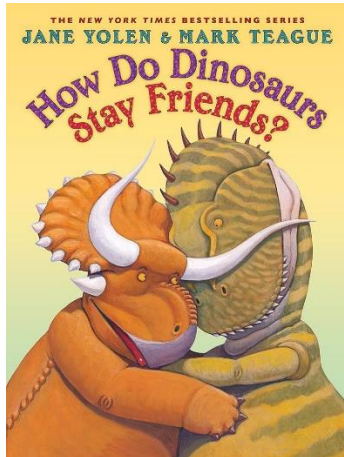


Story Walk Packet

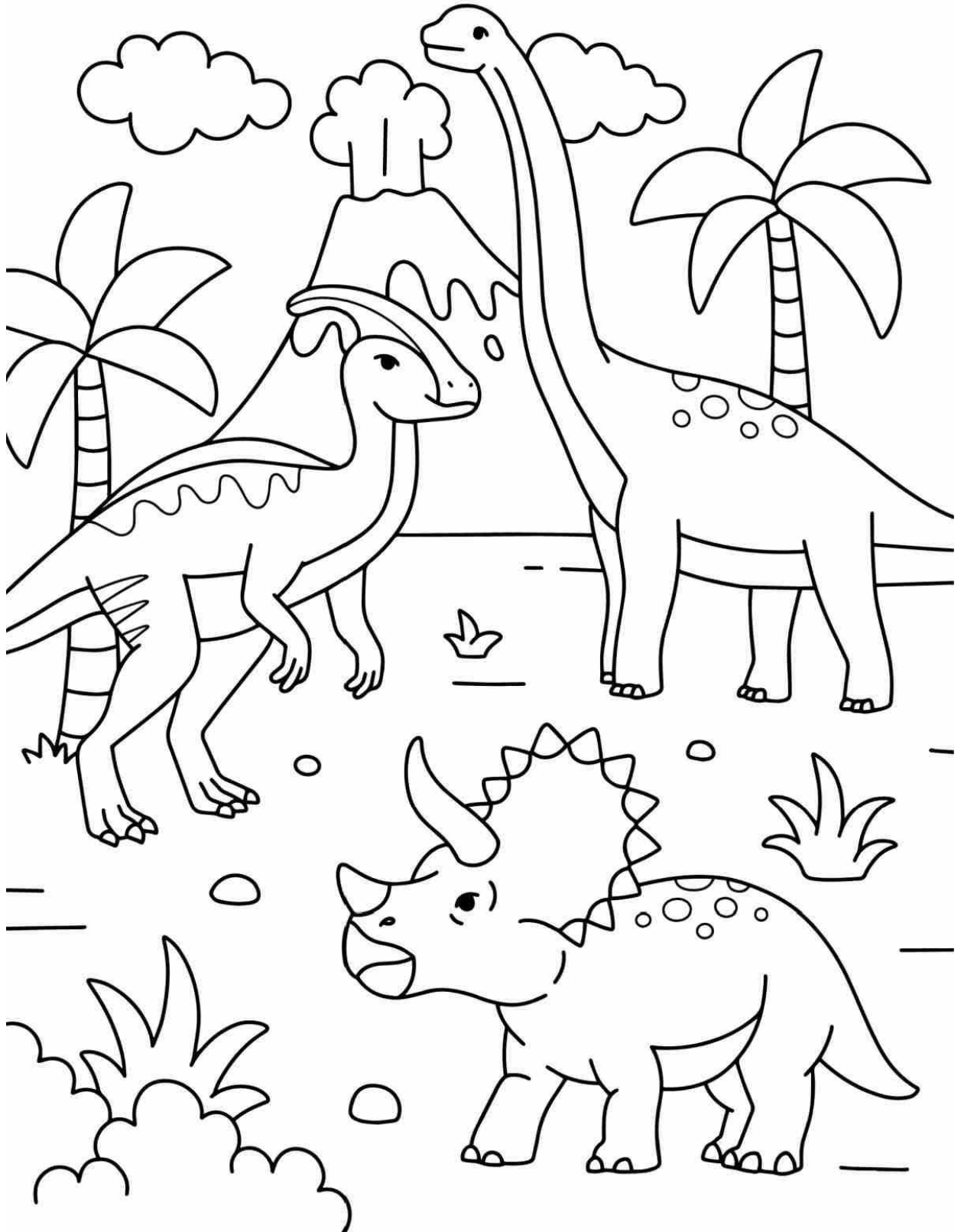
Important: Look for the Submission Form at the end of this packet and follow the directions.

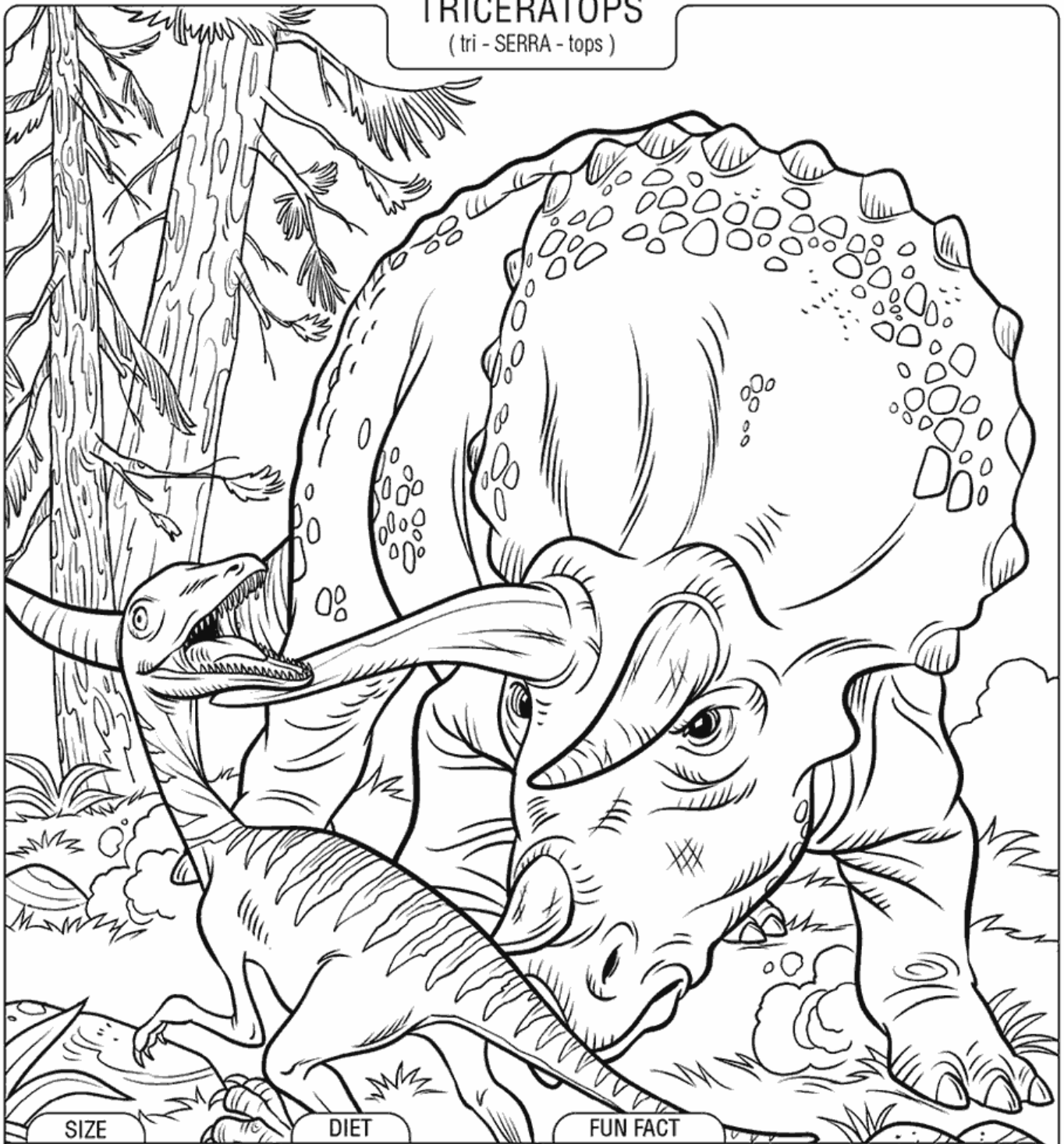

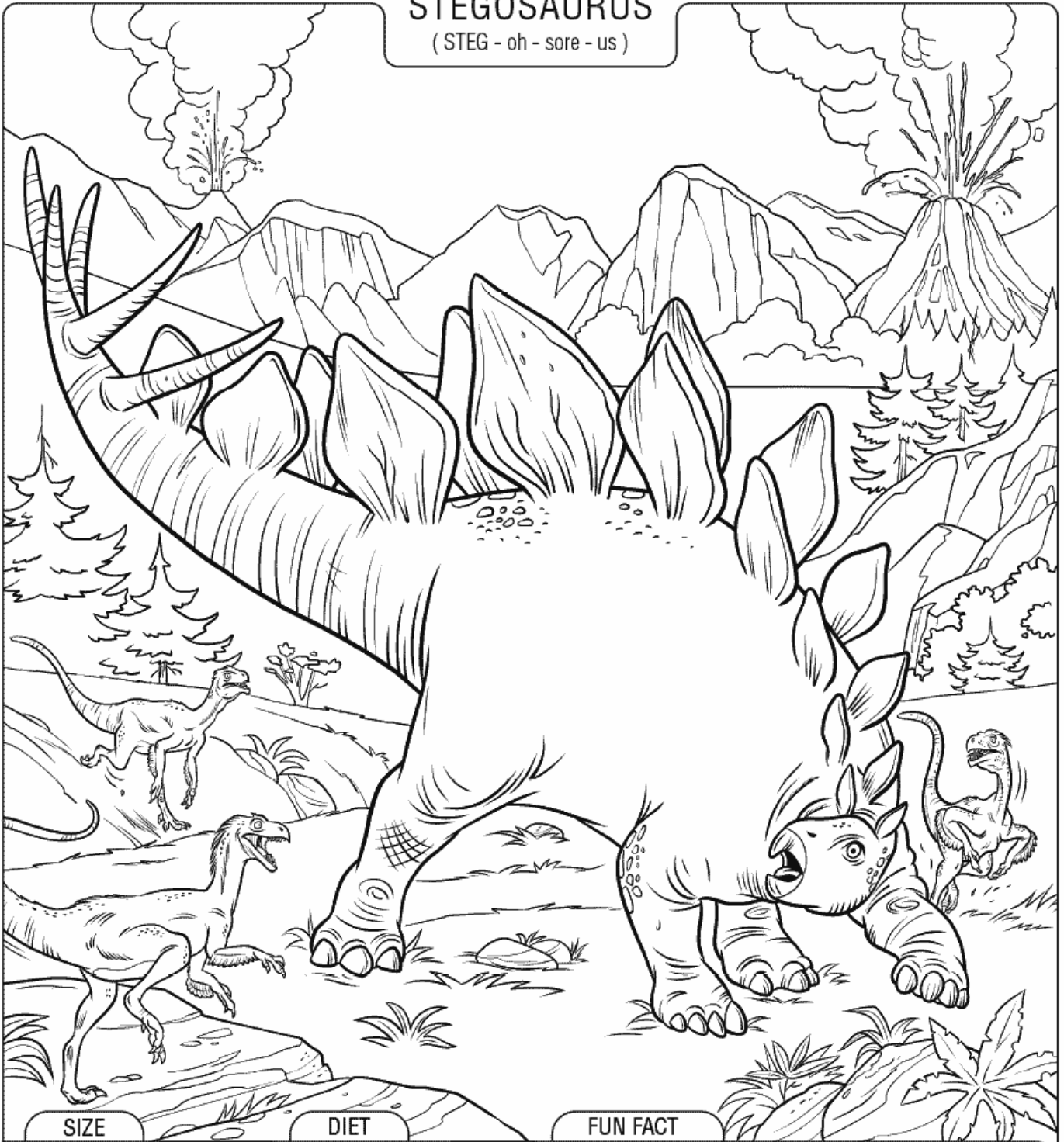

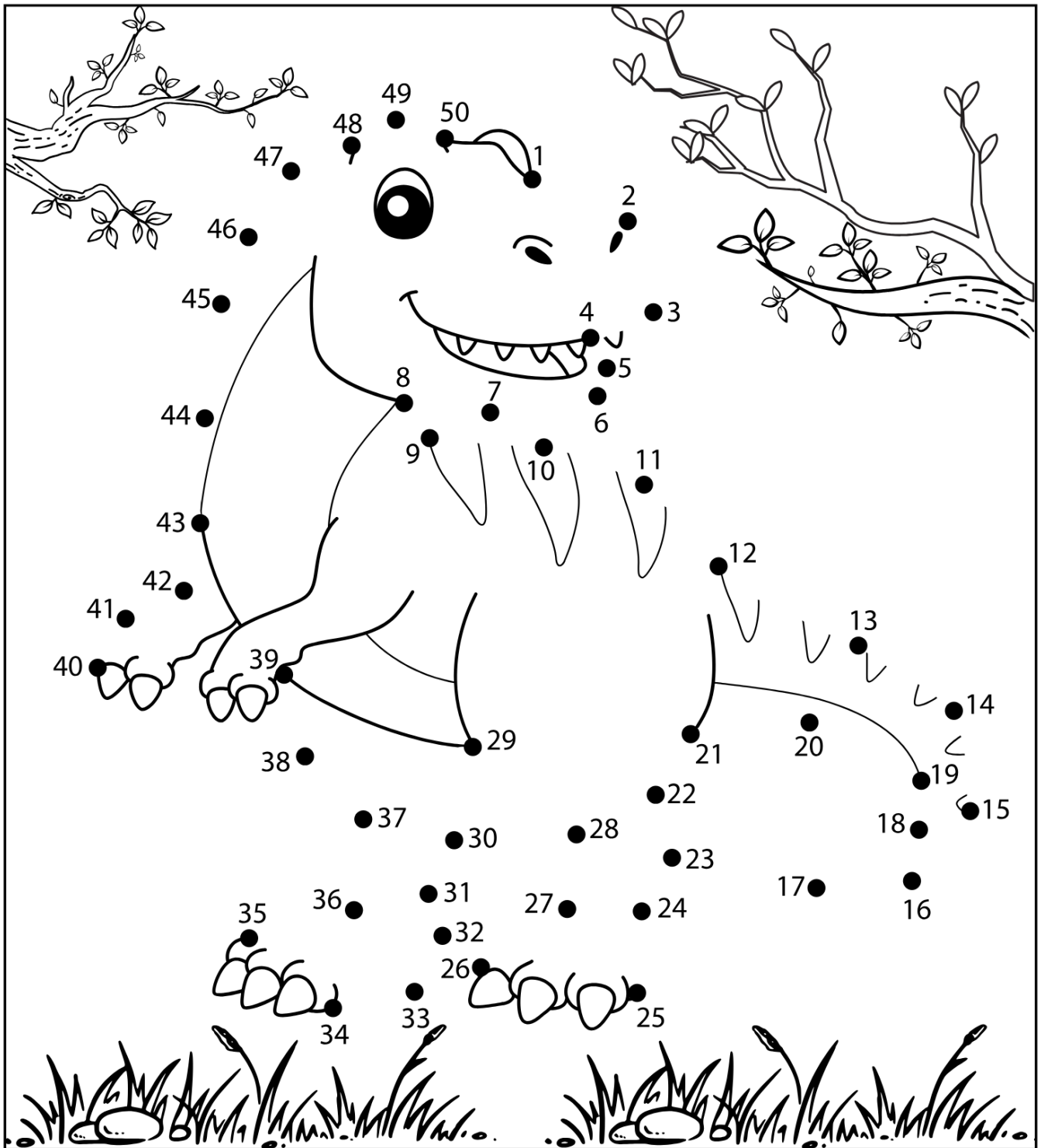

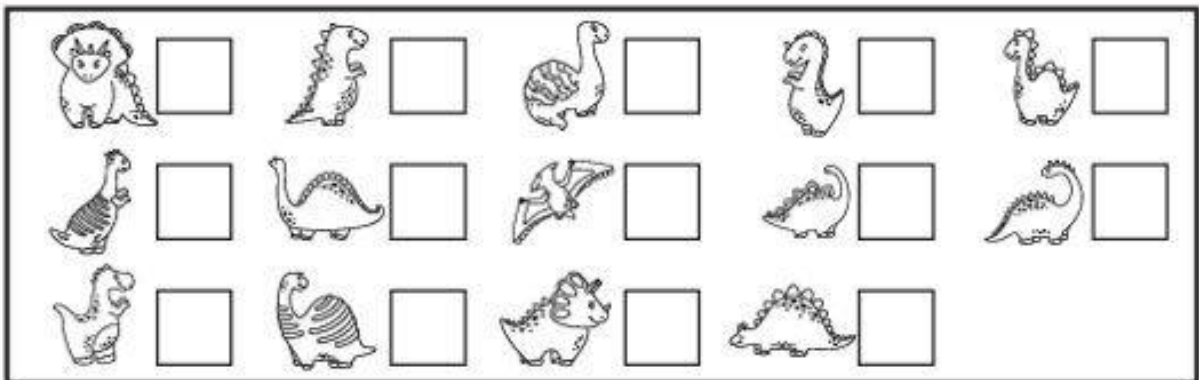
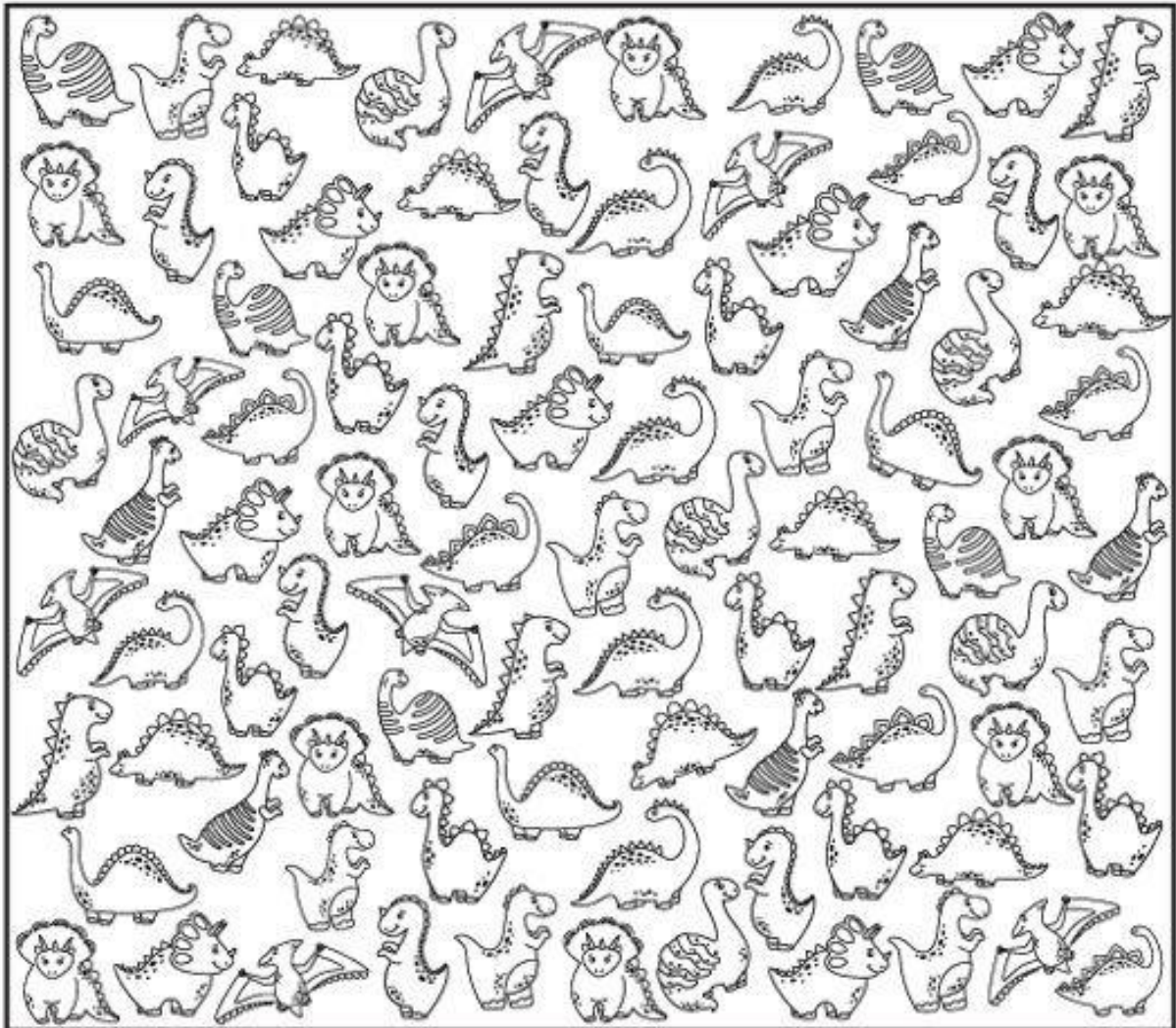
TYRANNOSAURUS

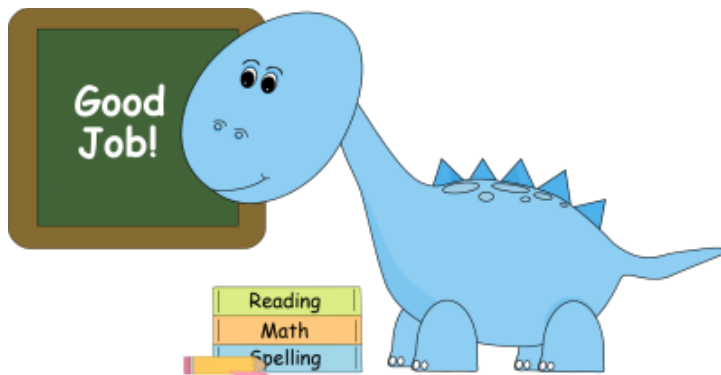
